IMMUNIZATION REMINDER

Three doses of hepatitis B vaccine are required for students entering school for the first time (i.e. kindergarten or first grade). The immunization card has been modified to accommodate this requirement. Also, Varicella (chicken pox) immunity is required, either from vaccination, history of disease or laboratory testing for new school admittance (i.e. kindergarten or first grade) and for students entering seventh grade.

Students who fail to have both hepatitis B vaccine and Varicella immunity will not be enrolled. Also, students are no longer required to undergo tuberculosis testing or screening. All of these modifications have been approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Health.
